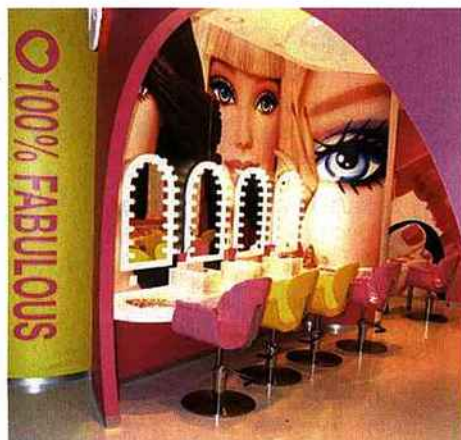

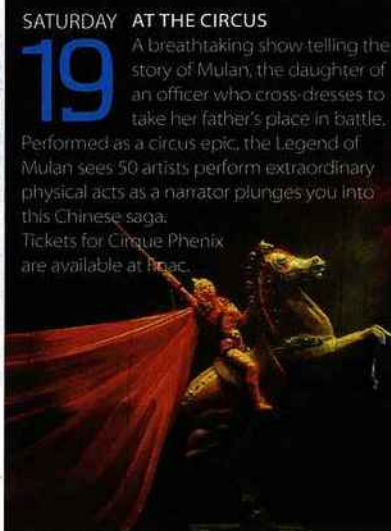
THURSDAY
